Directions

I 95 to exit 15 for the Route 7 connector expressway (north).

Take to EXIT 2 (Route 123). At the light at the end of the ramp turn right onto Route 123 north. At the next light turn right again continuing on Route 123.

Continue about 4 miles to the junction of Route 106. Turn right onto Route 106 north. Go about ¾ of a mile (second street on the right) and turn right onto Carter Street. NCMT is the 2nd driveway on the left.

I 84 TO EXIT 3 (for Route 7 south). Continue on Route 7 into the town of Wilton. At the intersection of Route 106 turn right. Continue on Route 106 to 1st stop sign – go straight. At the next stop sign turn left (continuing on Route 106). At the next stop sign turn left again (continuing on Route 106). At the next stop sign turn right (continuing on Route 106/Silvermine Road). Take your second left onto Carter Street (it is directly across from Canoe Hill Rd.) NCMT is the 2nd driveway on the left.

On July 20, 2016 we will be offering the following
equitation classes, open to riders with disabilities,
to follow Leadline.

These classes are Academy Classes & are ex-
empt from USEF/USHJA membership require-
ments. Classes \$25 each.

Tests may be to demonstrate a figure 8, a 3
cavaletti pole course or horsemanship questions.

Riders with Leaders and/or sidewalkers:
Open to riders who require the assistance of a
leader or leader and sidewalker.

Riders will Trot individually.

Riders with spotters: Open to riders who ride in-
dependently or who request the use of a spotter,
who are to remain a minimum distance of 5 feet
from the rider. Riders will trot individually. Test
may be performed at the walk or trot.

Rider Independent: Open to riders who ride inde-
pendently. Riders may have an assistant in the
center of the ring if they need directions repeated
